The first ever Girls in Dance Festival is a festival for girls aged 13-19 years who enjoy dancing to get inspired and empowered, learn about leadership and be part of a community of like-minded girls. This festival aims to change the way girls see themselves by offering a safe space to connect, grow and be themselves, using dance as a transformative tool in that journey.

Curated and organised by the Birmingham based charity AWA DANCE, this will be a unique in person event that aims to celebrate girls' futures with workshops, interactive stalls, Q&A and plenty of role models from leading organisations and individuals to inspire the next generation of girls through the power of dance. The festival aims to be a platform that will not only offer a good time but also be a space for critical thinking, where girls acquire skills to become change-makers in their personal and future professional lives. This festival will put special emphasis in representation and role models, celebrating global majority artists and people, reflecting the diversity of Birmingham and the Midlands.

The challenges of today's girls

Today's girls face many challenges, recent research shows that:

- Girls face significant appearance pressures from a young age (Girl Guides, 2021)
- 47% of girls aged 11-21 say how they look holds them back most of the time
- By age 7, girls are already less active than boys, and this disparity widens as they transition from childhood to adolescence
- 64% of girls will have quit sports altogether by the age of 16 or 17 (Girl Up, United Nations website)
- Despite dance being one of the most popular activities among girls, with 22% participating (Youth Sport Trust: Girls Active Survey), there is a significant drop-off in sports participation as girls grow older

Our festival aims to provide a supportive platform to boost girls' confidence and self-expression. By creating a safe environment free from pressures, we empower girls to pursue their passions and develop their skills.
