WHAT'S SPECIAL ABOUT OUR WORKSHOPS

We promote leadership skills that are rooted in our 21st century reality by questioning assumptions and allowing participants to take ownership of their life. To do so, we use movement (no dance training required) as well as reflection tools – such as handouts, journals, mind maps, short dance films, digital surveys, group tasks, meditation techniques and open conversations – to work with our participants.

We always include a self-reflection exercise for the participants, which then becomes an impact report for your organisation. The report contains useful data for you to show your funders or your leadership team the impact our workshops have had.

Photos will be taken on our practitioner's phone and then uploaded to our Google Drive within 24 hours and deleted from the phone's history, if you prefer to use your own electronic devices please send us the pictures. All our workshop leaders are DBS checked and have safeguarding training.
